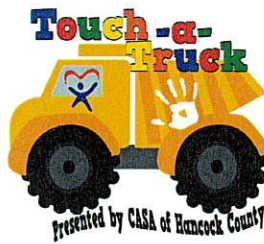

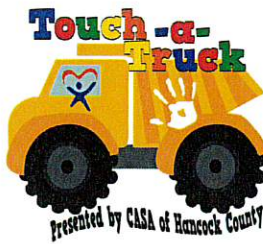

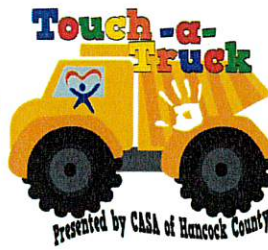

Vehicle Participant Guidelines:

Registration Deadline: Applications will be accepted on a first received basis. To guarantee inclusion in the event publicity, registration must be received by March 17, 2023. All vehicles must be delivered by 9:00 am and must stay in place until 2:30 pm.

Signage and Publicity:

- Promotional materials appropriate for children, such as stickers and giveaways, are strongly encouraged and welcomed.

What To Bring:

- Electricity—Please supply your own electricity. If you are bringing a generator, please let us know in advance.
- Pop-Up Tent—You are responsible for bringing a pop-up tent if desired.
- Tables and chairs for use at your vehicle station.

Participation Guidelines:

- The Vehicle Commitment Form must be received by March 17, 2023 in order to participate.
- Vehicle space assignments will be determined by CASA of Hancock County based upon the best interests of the event and/or first-come-first-serve basis. Vehicles will be located in the Hancock County Government Annex parking lot.
- Vehicle participants acknowledge that a minimum of one adult representative must be present during the event to supervise the Vehicle(s) between the hours of 10:00 am to 2:00 pm on Saturday, October 16, 2021. Vehicle representative(s) should be able to provide a narrative description of the Vehicle(s) specifications and/or services as well as facilitate guided “tours” of the Vehicle(s) interior as allowable by the Vehicle’s size.
- Vehicle Participants acknowledge that the nature of the Touch a Truck event involves the interaction of children with Participant’s vehicle(s) so that the children are able to touch, see, and explore the vehicle(s) and learn about the vehicle’s function. CASA of Hancock County will take appropriate measures to facilitate a safe event; however, the Vehicle Participant remains responsible for the supervision and safety of its vehicle(s). The Vehicle Participant shall defend, indemnify, save, and hold harmless CASA of Hancock County and its officers, directors employees, and volunteers from any and all liability, damage, loss, claims, costs demands and actions of any nature whatsoever arising out of the Touch a Truck event.
- Vehicle Participants must arrive on the event day (Saturday, April 1, 2023) between 7:00am and 9:00am to set-up. Vehicles requiring special accommodations, such as a large turning radius, will be asked to arrive early during event set-up. Vehicles are expected to stay the entire length of the event

and may not leave until 30 minutes after the event's conclusion at 2:00 pm unless otherwise agreed to in advance by CASA of Hancock County.

- Participants may bring banners, signage, decorations, giveaways etc. to promote their business. CASA of Hancock County shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage to vendor property and shall not be responsible for any damage (property or bodily injury related) caused by said vendor property.
- Participants grant permission to CASA of Hancock County to take photographs or record videos of vendor and/or display during the event for the strict purpose of promotion and publicity of the event and/or CASA of Hancock County.
- Participants and their representatives shall conduct themselves in a manner that is appropriate for the family-oriented event, which includes but is not limited to the following restrictions: No smoking, no alcoholic beverages, no profanity, and no display of inappropriate content or clothing. In the event of inappropriate behavior at the event, CASA of Hancock County reserves the right to close the participant's booth.
